

INSTRUCTIONS: MINIATURE SALES AND SILENT AUCTION ROOM 525

1. MINIATURE SALES

Monday August 18: Bring your miniatures to the room **from 14.00 to 18.00**

Sell your miniatures by yourself. Please introduce yourself with a card stating your name and when you'll be available for sales during the congress.

2. SILENT AUCTION

The proceeds of the silent auction go to the ISST to support developing countries and associations.

Tuesday and Wednesday: You can place a bid **from 10.00 to 19.00**

Thursday: Highest bidders are announced **from 10.00**.
Pick up and pay for your miniatures **from 14:00 - 17:00**.

Procedure:

1. **On the table**, there will be several small cardboard trays where you can display one special item or a small collection of miniatures. You can also put them in a transparent plastic bag.
2. Provide a **unique name** e.g. "Farm Animal Collection", or "A bit of everything."
3. **Complete the bidding guide** and place it next to your item/s. Provide a short description of the items on the back of this card, as well as your name and country. See example below.
